ORDER DISMISSING CLAIM WITH PREJUDICE

This proceeding arose from a complaint filed under the employee protection provisions of Section 507 of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act (“FWPCA”), 33 U.S.C. § 1367, and the procedural regulations found at 29 C.F.R. Part 24.

On January 18, 2018, the parties filed a *Joint Stipulation of Dismissal and Motion for Withdrawal of Complainant’s Claims*, signed by all parties. The parties state that they met on January 15, 2018 and reached a settlement that resolved all of the matters that were in dispute. Complainant states that he wishes to withdraw his objections to the underlying OSHA determination pursuant to 29 C.F.R. § 24.111(c) and the parties jointly request that the claim be dismissed.

Based on the foregoing, the parties’ Joint Motion is **GRANTED** and the claim is **DISMISSED** with prejudice. The Secretary’s Findings shall be the Final Order of the Secretary. See Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(ii); *see also* 29 C.F.R. § 24.111(c).
